

## Understanding Document Count Differences in TI TI v 10.4

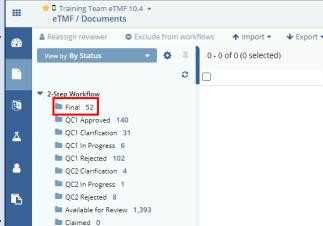
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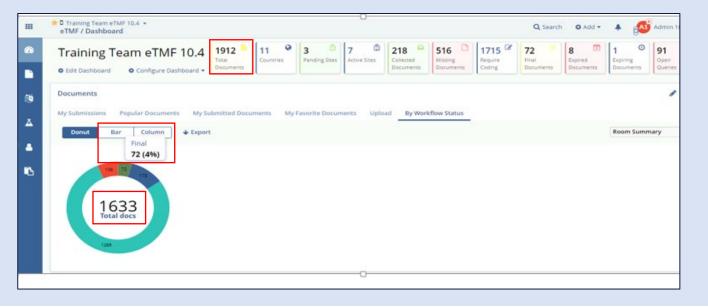

Occasionally, users may notice that document counts on the **By Workflow** dashlet may not match up with the **KPI** metrics or **By Status** view within the **Documents Module**.

## Take a look at these examples:

- The Final count in the By Status view in the Documents Module is different than the Final count on the By Workflow Status dashlet on the dashboard.
- The Total Docs view on the dashlet is different from the Total Docs KPI tile.





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## These discrepancies can be a result of any of the following reasons:

- The total finalized documents might have to be calculated/included from other folders as well. (ex. Rejected, inbox etc.) --> The dashlet would be correct, while the By Status counts would not be correct.
- 2. Documents may be rejected outside the workflow --> The dashlet would be correct, but the counts would not be correct.
- 3. "Unclaimed" can be documents that are in any stage of the workflow, not just the first step. --> The dashlet would be correct, while the counts would not be correct.
- Documents can be rejected as "on hold", and then the doc could be made final. --> The dashlet would be correct, but the counts would not be correct.
- 3. Documents can be "Final" and rejected outside of the workflow, but the dashboards are based on the workflow → The dashlet would be correct, but the counts would not be correct.
- 6. The total documents may or may not include deleted documents which might affect the count when compared with the dashlet and metrics bar at the top of the screen. --> The dashlet would be correct, while counts would not necessarily be correct.
